Literacy Volunteers- Marquette County Remembers 2 Volunteers



Marie Budney was a former tutor/volunteer with LV-MC, who passed away November 17 at the age of 83. She was our Oxford area literacy contact for many years beginning in the 1990s when she and her husband moved from Milwaukee to Oxford. She had retired from literacy volunteering a few years ago. We appreciated her work with literacy students very much.



Bette Whitrock, who passed away January 11, was an active member of the Literacy Volunteers of Marquette County for 20 years. She and her husband Karl sponsored "Read For Joy" books for years when they owned Johnson's Boats & Motors. The books were distributed to first time mothers in Marquette County through the county nurses.

One of her favorite activities was the Tots to Teens Book Drive, which takes place each December in conjunction with the county social services Christmas gift giveaway.

Most of all, Bette felt helping the 3rd grade students at Forest Lane Elementary School increase their reading ability was a rewarding part of her life.

Bette loved the saying which hangs in her front room: "One hundred years from now it will not matter what kind of house I lived in, how much money I had, nor what clothes I wore, but the world may be a little better because I was important in the life of a child."

We will miss her.

We are thankful for the memorials in Bette Whitrock's name which we received through her family. It totaled \$1,290.00. Karl and daughter Chara Hall attended the LV-MC Mecan fundraiser in February and presented Vicki Huffman, LV-MC President, with the memorials.
