Literacy Volunteers-Marquette County's Tots to Teens Book Drive

Literacy Volunteers-Marquette County's annual Tots to Teens Book Drive produced over 1000 donated books from drop-off points at county libraries, schools, and churches. The book giveaway was held in conjunction with the Giving Tree program on Saturday morning, December 10th, at Trinity Methodist Church in Montello.

The method of distribution has changed from parents selecting the books to LV-MC volunteers selecting and bagging the books for 119 families by numbers assigned families. This is a continuation of a practice begun by the Giving Tree during the Covid restrictions. Paula Chambers, head of the Giving Tree, and her crew added the book bags to the rest of each family's gifts.

Volunteers who sorted books were Rita Socha, Chuck Bornhoeft, Barbara Church, Janis Wells, Annelie Palmer, Vicki Huffman, and Anne Oelke, who contributed 16 hours. Vicki and Anne and Bob Oelke selected, bagged, and delivered the books to Trinity Methodist Church. This was an additional 18 hours.

Several boxes of YA (Young Adult) books were saved, which may be delivered to the Boys & Girls Club of the Tri County Area in Berlin. In addition, some of the books written in Spanish were set aside for use at UMOS, which will be reopening in late spring.
