Literacy Volunteers-Marquette County is sponsoring an essay contest to celebrate September—Literacy Month! The topic chosen for this year's contest mirrors the Summer Library Reading program: "Reading helps me Dream Big because..."

Information and entry forms were available at all Marquette County libraries and were to be returned to one of them by September 8th – International Literacy Day. Age categories were divided into four groups: age 7 and under; 8-11; 12-15; and 16 and up. When judging is completed, the winning entries will be printed in the Marquette County Tribune. All winners will be awarded \$15 universal gift cards.

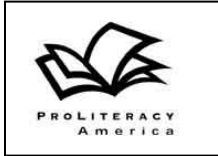
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One can find the current newsletter, various volunteer/tutor/forms and more. There will also be updated pictures from our May Volunteer Appreciation Dinner soon.
